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HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, Public transportation serves an important role in 3 meeting the transportation needs of many State citizens; and

4 WHEREAS, The State may benefit from the consolidation of 5 transit services provided by the the mass Regional 6 Transportation Authority, the Commuter Rail Board, the 7 Suburban Bus Board, and the Chicago Transit Authority; the 8 consolidation of mass transit services may provide citizens 9 with a more effective and cost efficient means of public 10 transportation; therefore, be it

11 RESOLVED, ΒY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 12 NINETY-SEVENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, THE 13 SENATE CONCURRING HEREIN, that the Mass Transit Consolidation 14 Commission is created for the purpose of researching and discussing whether the Regional Transportation Authority, the 15 Commuter Rail Board, the Suburban Bus Board, and the Chicago 16 17 Transit Authority should be consolidated under one 18 governmental structure; and be it further

19 RESOLVED, That the Commission shall be composed of 16 20 voting members as follows:

(1) 2 members of the Illinois House of Representatives,
 one appointed by the Speaker of the House and one appointed

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by the House Minority Leader;

2 (2) 2 members of the Illinois Senate, one appointed by
3 the Senate President and one appointed by the Senate
4 Minority Leader;

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(3) 2 public members appointed by the Governor;

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6 (4) 5 members whose residences are located in DuPage, 7 Kane, Lake, McHenry, or Will County, one appointed by the 8 county chairperson in each of those counties;

9 (5) 2 members whose residences are located in Cook 10 County, each appointed by the chairperson of Cook County;

(6) 2 members of the Amalgamated Transit Union, each
 appointed by the Governor; and

(7) one member whose residence is located in the area
served by the Suburban Bus Board appointed by the
chairperson of the Suburban Bus Board; and be it further

16 RESOLVED, That the Governor of the State of Illinois shall 17 appoint one non-voting member to serve as the chair of the 18 Commission; and be it further

19 RESOLVED, That a person appointed as a public member of the 20 Commission must have expertise and experience in the area of 21 public transportation; and be it further

22 RESOLVED, That a member of the Commission is not entitled 23 to compensation but is entitled to reimbursement for the travel HJ0029 -3- LRB097 11548 JDS 54474 r expenses incurred by the member while transacting Commission business; and be it further

3 RESOLVED, That the Commission shall meet at least monthly 4 at the times and places that the chair designates; and be it 5 further

RESOLVED, That a majority of the members of the Commission
constitute a quorum for transacting Commission business; and be
it further

9 RESOLVED, That the Commission shall prepare and issue a 10 report to the Governor and the General Assembly by July 1, 11 2012, setting forth the findings and conclusions of the 12 Commission concerning whether viable and sustainable transit 13 service can be provided for the northeast region of the State; 14 and be it further

RESOLVED, That the report must include an outline of the Commission's meetings and any recommendations for legislation that may be necessary to implement the consolidation of mass transit services if the Commission finds that consolidation is necessary; and be it further

20 RESOLVED, That the Commission must hold at least one public 21 hearing in each of the counties served by the Regional HJ0029 -4- LRB097 11548 JDS 54474 r 1 Transportation Authority, the Commuter Rail Board, the 2 Suburban Bus Board, and the Chicago Transit Authority in order 3 to receive public input concerning the consolidation of mass 4 transit services; and be it further

5 RESOLVED, That the Illinois Department of Transportation 6 shall provide administrative and other support to the 7 Commission.
