2 WHEREAS, Current federal law allows a home mortgage 3 interest deduction for the interest paid on a taxpayers primary 4 and secondary homes, and current proposals to reform or 5 eliminate the mortgage interest deduction are being debated; 6 and

WHEREAS, Deductions for mortgage interest have been part of the tax code since its inception in 1913, and eliminating the mortgage interest deduction would have a negative impact on the Illinois economy, job creation, and home ownership; and

WHEREAS, Eliminating the deduction would be harmful to current home owners and future home buyers; the mortgage interest deduction is a cornerstone of the American housing policy; and

WHEREAS, When purchasing a home, buyers often rely on the benefits of the mortgage interest deduction; without the deduction, many families would not be able to afford their homes; and

WHEREAS, Home owners do not expect to lose their mortgage interest deduction, and prospective buyers anticipate taking the deduction; changes to these "rules of the game" would have

- 1 a significant impact on the market in terms of home buyer and
- 2 home owner behavior; and
- 3 WHEREAS, The deduction is most valuable for younger
- 4 households who tend to be recent home buyers with small amounts
- 5 of home equity and growing families due to marriages and
- 6 children; therefore, be it
- 7 RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
- 8 NINETY-SEVENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that
- 9 we urge Congress to insure that the mortgage interest tax
- 10 credit is not eliminated and that working families continue to
- 11 receive this benefit to support economic growth and encourage
- 12 home ownership; and be it further
- 13 RESOLVED, That suitable copies of this resolution be
- 14 provided to the President of the United States, the Majority
- 15 Leader and Minority Leader of the United States Senate, the
- 16 Speaker and Minority Leader of the United States House of
- 17 Representatives, and each member of the Illinois congressional
- 18 delegation.
