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AMENDMENT TO HOUSE RESOLUTION 550

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AMENDMENT NO. ____. Amend House Resolution 550 by replacing on page 1, lines 2 through 20 and all of pages 2 through 5 with the following:

5 "WHEREAS, Virtually every week there are media reports of 6 tragedies and crimes involving handguns; and

7 WHEREAS, The illegal influx of firearms into the State of
8 Illinois causes risk and harm to law enforcement officers and
9 to the law-abiding residents of Illinois; and

10 WHEREAS, Individuals who are not legally authorized to 11 possess firearms in Illinois commit crimes with guns that 12 result in murders, serious injuries, and significant property 13 losses; and

14 WHEREAS, Although there are exceptions related to law

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1 enforcement and private security functions, the State of 2 Illinois at this time does not have a law permitting the 3 concealed carry of a handgun; and

WHEREAS, The general public and members of the General Assembly could benefit from a study of how a change in the law in Illinois to permit the concealed carry of a handgun could be expected to impact communities, law enforcement, the illegal influx of firearms into the State, and the nature and number of serious gun crimes; therefore, be it

10 RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 11 NINETY-SEVENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that 12 there is created the Firearm Public Awareness Task Force; and 13 be it further

RESOLVED, That the task force is charged with finding and 14 15 analyzing data from states that have concealed carry laws, 16 especially those states with significant similarities to 17 Illinois; the inquiry and study should include information 18 about the types and number of crimes involving handguns before and after the date that a concealed carry law went into effect 19 20 in each state and particularly for the following categories: 21 violent qun crimes; suicides by firearm; number of quns, or qun 22 owners, legally registered; number of registered guns stolen or 23 number of guns stolen from registered gun owners; and be it

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1 further

2 RESOLVED, That the task force should additionally gather 3 information from similar states with concealed carry laws 4 concerning: the number and nature of serious crimes committed by persons who were lawfully carrying a concealed weapon at the 5 time of the crime; and the number of people killed or injured 6 7 when a person who was lawfully carrying a concealed weapon used 8 the concealed weapon or made known to the assailant that he or 9 she was carrying a concealed weapon; and be it further

10 RESOLVED, That the task force should also consider, if a 11 concealed carry law is passed in Illinois, how public safety 12 could be maintained, whether a change in the law would create a 13 need for police sensitivity training, and what type of public 14 information campaign about a concealed carry law would be 15 appropriate; and be it further

16 RESOLVED, That the task force shall be comprised of the 17 following members, all of whom shall serve without 18 compensation:

19 (1) five representatives appointed by the Speaker of20 the House of Representatives;

(2) five representatives appointed by the Minority
 Leader of the House of Representatives;

(3) a representative of the Department of State Police

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1 appointed by the Director of the Department; (4) a representative of the Cook County Sheriff's 2 3 office appointed by the Cook County Sheriff; 4 (5) a representative of the Illinois State's 5 Attorneys' Association appointed by the head of that 6 organization; (6) a representative of the Illinois Fraternal Order of 7 8 Police appointed by the head of that organization; 9 (7)а representative of the Illinois Sheriffs 10 Association appointed by the head of that organization; 11 (8) a representative of The National Rifle Association of America appointed by the head of that organization; 12 (9) a representative of the Illinois State Rifle 13 14 Association appointed by the head of that organization; 15 (10) a representative of the Illinois Council Against 16 Violence appointed by the head of Handgun that 17 organization; and (11) a representative from the Illinois Firearms 18 19 Manufacturers Association appointed by the head of that 20 organization; and be it further 21 RESOLVED, That the Speaker shall designate a member of the 22 task force to serve as the chairperson; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Department of State Police shall provide
 administrative and other support to the task force for no more

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1 than 3 meetings; and be it further

2 RESOLVED, That the task force shall hold public hearings 3 and shall issue a written report of its findings and 4 recommendations to the General Assembly on or before March 1, 5 2012; and that upon filing its report the task force is 6 dissolved.".
