HOUSE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, February 7, 2012, marks the 12th year of the 3 commemoration and observance of National African-American 4 HIV/AIDS Awareness Day; and

5 WHEREAS, This observance is a nationwide effort to mobilize 6 African-American communities to get educated, get tested, get 7 involved, and get treated for HIV/AIDS, as it continues to 8 devastate African-American communities; and

9 WHEREAS, National African-American HIV/AIDS Awareness Day 10 directed, planned, and strategically is implemented by organizations to mobilize community-based 11 HIV/AIDS 12 organizations and stakeholders involved in HIV/AIDS prevention, care, and treatment; and 13

14 WHEREAS, Nearly 60,000 residents of Illinois are living 15 with HIV and 55% of reported HIV diagnoses are 16 African-Americans; and

WHEREAS, Among African-Americans ages 25-44, HIV was the fourth leading cause of death for men and third leading cause of death for women, higher than any other racial group; and
