Rieman on 4 being the recipient of the 2012 Dare to Lead Award, presented 5 by the International Leadership Network; and 6 WHEREAS, A native of Wisconsin, he began his journey in 7 higher education by earning a Bachelor of Arts degree and 8 Doctor of Laws degree from the University of Wisconsin in 9 Madison; and 10 WHEREAS, He and his wife, Phyllis, had the good sense to move to Evanston, where they began their family; and 11 12 WHEREAS, He began his professional career working for W. 13 Clement Stone as a professional assistant, specializing in philanthropic programs providing scholarships 14 and programs for pastors, lawyers, community service, and youth 15 service personnel; and 16 17 WHEREAS, Gary H. Rieman became the first Director of the 18 Illinois Designated Account Purchase Program in 1977, making him the architect of the State of Illinois' first student loan 19 20 secondary market; and

1 WHEREAS, Under his leadership, the Illinois Designated 2 Account Purchase Program grew to become one of the nation's 3 premier student loan secondary markets, assisting thousands of 4 Illinois students in avoiding going into default by providing

- 7 Dare to Lead Award, the organization's highest award; and

- 9 all ages for nearly 50 years; he is living proof that one
- 10 person can truly make a difference, and has shown that with
- intellect, grace, and humor; therefore, be it
