1 HOUSE RESOLUTION WHEREAS, Hamas was founded with the stated goal of 2 3 destroying the State of Israel; and WHEREAS, Hamas has been designated by the United States 4 Secretary of State as a Foreign Terrorist Organization; and 5 6 WHEREAS, Hamas refuses to recognize Israel's right to 7 exist, renounce violence, and accept previous agreements 8 between Israel and the Palestinians; and 9 WHEREAS, Hamas has launched thousands of rockets and missiles since Israel dismantled settlements and withdrew from 10 11 Gaza in 2005; and 12 WHEREAS, Terrorists in the Hamas-controlled Gaza Strip have fired approximately 900 rockets and missile shells into 13 14 Israel this year, an increase from roughly 675 attacks in 2011 and 350 in 2010; and 15 16 WHEREAS, Hamas has increased the range of its rockets, 17 reportedly with support from Iran and others; these rockets put additional numbers of Israelis in danger of rocket attacks from 18 19 Gaza; and

- 1 WHEREAS, There are many public and private connections
- 2 between the State of Illinois and the State of Israel and a
- desire to deepen and expand mutual opportunities; and
- WHEREAS, On November 14, 2012, President Barack Obama
- 5 condemned the rocket fire from Gaza into Israel and reiterated
- 6 Israel's right to self-defense; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Israel, a fellow democracy, has an inherent right
- 8 to self defense in the face of terrorist attacks; therefore, be
- 9 it
- 10 RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
- 11 NINETY-SEVENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that
- 12 we express our unwavering commitment to the security of the
- 13 State of Israel as a Jewish and democratic state with secure
- 14 borders and recognize and strongly support its inherent right
- 15 to act in self-defense to protect its citizens against acts of
- 16 terrorism; and be it further
- 17 RESOLVED, That we state our unequivocal belief that Hamas
- 18 must end Gaza-linked terrorist rocket and missile attacks
- 19 against Israel, recognize Israel's right to exist, renounce
- 20 violence, and agree to accept previous agreements between
- 21 Israel and the Palestinians; and be it further

1 RESOLVED, That we urge the United Nations Security Council 2 to condemn the recent spike in Gaza-linked terrorist missile 3 attacks against Israel, which risk causing civilian casualties 4 in both Israel and Gaza; and be it further

RESOLVED, That we encourage the President to continue to work diplomatically with the international community to prevent Hamas and other Gaza-based terrorist organizations from retaining or rebuilding the capability to launch rockets and missiles against Israel.
