SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 4003/10 20 ILCS 4003/15 20 ILCS 4003/17 new 20 ILCS 4003/20

Amends the Mississippi River Coordinating Council Act. Provides that the Mississippi River Coordinating Council shall include a standing subcommittee called the Mississippi River Parkway Subcommittee (the Subcommittee). Provides that the Subcommittee shall consist of 6 public members residing within counties in the State that are adjacent to the Mississippi River and ex-officio members from the State with specific knowledge of the Mississippi River. Provides that the chairperson of the Mississippi River Coordinating Council shall appoint the Subcommittee members and that the Subcommittee members shall be non-voting members of the Council. Sets forth the duties of the Subcommittee. Effective immediately.

AN ACT concerning State government.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Mississippi River Coordinating Council Act 5 is amended by changing Sections 10, 15, and 20 and adding 6 Section 17 as follows:

7 (20 ILCS 4003/10)

8 Sec. 10. Mississippi River Coordinating Council.

9 There is established the Mississippi (a) River Coordinating Council (Council), consisting of 13 voting 10 members to be appointed by the Governor. One member shall be 11 the Lieutenant Governor who shall serve as a voting member and 12 13 as chairperson of the Council. The agency members of the 14 Council shall include the Directors, or their designees, of the following: the Department of Agriculture, the Department of 15 16 Commerce and Economic Opportunity, the Illinois Environmental 17 Protection Agency, the Department of Natural Resources, and the Department of Transportation. In addition, the Council shall 18 19 include one member representing Soil and Water Conservation Districts located in the proximity of the Mississippi River and 20 21 its tributaries, and 6 members representing local communities, 22 not-for-profit organizations working to protect the Mississippi River and 23 its tributaries, businesses,

agriculture, recreation, conservation, and the environment. 1 2 Additionally, the Council shall include a standing subcommittee called the Mississippi River Parkway Subcommittee 3 (Subcommittee). The Subcommittee shall consist of 6 public 4 5 members residing within counties in the State that are adjacent to the Mississippi River and ex-officio members from the State 6 7 with specific knowledge of the Mississippi River. The Subcommittee members, including the chairperson, shall be 8 9 appointed by the chairperson of the Council. The Subcommittee members shall be non-voting members of the Council. The 10 11 chairperson of the Subcommittee shall also serve as the 12 Illinois representative to the National Mississippi River 13 Parkway Commission.

(b) The Governor may appoint, as ex-officio members, individuals representing the interests of the states who border the Mississippi River and individuals representing federal agencies.

(c) Members of the Council shall serve 2-year terms, except
that of the initial appointments, 5 members shall be appointed
to serve 3-year terms and 4 members to serve one-year terms.

(d) The Council shall meet at least quarterly.

(e) The Office of the Lieutenant Governor shall be
responsible for the operations of the Council, including,
without limitation, funding and oversight of the Council's
activities. The Office may reimburse members of the Council for
travel expenses.

Sec. 15. Duties of the Council. The Council shall:

6 (1) periodically review activities and programs 7 administered by State and federal agencies that directly 8 impact the Mississippi River and its tributaries;

9 (2) work with local communities and organizations to 10 encourage partnerships that enhance awareness and 11 capabilities to address watershed and water resource 12 concerns and to encourage strategies that protect, 13 restore, and expand critical habitats and soil 14 conservation and water quality practices;

15 (3) work with State and federal agencies to optimize 16 the expenditure of funds affecting the Mississippi River 17 and its tributaries;

18 (4) advise and make recommendations to the Governor and 19 State agencies on ways to better coordinate the expenditure 20 of appropriated funds affecting the Mississippi River and 21 its tributaries;

16 Sec. 17. Duties of the Subcommittee. The Subcommittee 17 shall: 18 (1) Analyze the programs established by or associated with interstate compacts, planning groups, commissions, 19 State agencies, local agencies, and any other related 20 21 entities that are involved in air, water, and land use 22 activities along the Mississippi River to determine their 23 relationship to the objectives of the Subcommittee. 24 (2) Submit reports to the Council detailing the Subcommittee's progress in meeting the requirements of 25
