Sec. 1-164.5. Proof of financial responsibility. Proof of ability to respond in damages for any liability thereafter incurred resulting from the ownership, maintenance, use or operation of a motor vehicle for bodily injury to or death of any person in the amount of \$20,000, and subject to this limit for any one person injured or killed, in the amount of \$40,000 for bodily injury to or death of 2 or more persons in any one accident, and for damage to property in the amount of \$15,000 resulting from any one accident. This proof in these amounts shall be furnished for each motor vehicle registered by every

- 1 person required to furnish this proof.
- 2 In the case of the revocation of a driver's license of any
- 3 person under Section 6-205 of this Code, "proof of financial
- 4 responsibility" means proof of ability to respond in damages
- 5 for any liability thereafter incurred resulting from the
- 6 ownership, maintenance, use or operation of a motor vehicle for
- 7 bodily injury or death of any person in the amount of \$50,000,
- and subject to this limit for any one person injured or killed, 8
- 9 in the amount of \$100,000 for bodily injury to or death of 2 or
- 10 more persons in any one accident, and for damage to property in
- the amount of \$40,000 resulting from any one accident. This 11
- proof in these amounts shall be furnished for each motor 12
- vehicle registered by every person required to furnish this 13
- 14 proof.

- 16 Assembly may be referred to as Devin's Law.
