1 AN ACT concerning transportation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing

 Section 18b-101 as follows:
- 6 (625 ILCS 5/18b-101) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 18b-101)
- 7 Sec. 18b-101. Definitions. Unless the context otherwise
- 8 clearly requires, as used in this Chapter:
- 9 "Agricultural commodities" means any agricultural
- 10 commodity, non-processed food, feed, fiber, or livestock,
- including insects.
- 12 "Agricultural operations" means the operation of a motor
- vehicle or combination of vehicles transporting agricultural
- 14 commodities or farm supplies for agricultural purposes.
- "Air mile" means a nautical mile, which is equivalent to
- 16 6,076 feet or 1,852 meters. Accordingly, 100 air miles are
- 17 equivalent to 115.08 statute miles or 185.2 kilometers.
- "Commercial motor vehicle" means any self propelled or
- 19 towed vehicle used on public highways in interstate and
- 20 intrastate commerce to transport passengers or property when
- 21 the vehicle has a gross vehicle weight, a gross vehicle weight
- 22 rating, a gross combination weight, or a gross combination
- 23 weight rating of 10,001 or more pounds; or the vehicle is used

or designed to transport more than 15 passengers, including the driver; or the vehicle is designed to carry 15 or fewer passengers and is operated by a contract carrier transporting employees in the course of their employment on a highway of this State; or the vehicle is used or designed to transport between 9 and 15 passengers, including the driver, for direct compensation, if the vehicle is being operated beyond a radius of 75 air miles (86.3 statute miles or 138.9 kilometers) from the driver's normal work reporting location; or the vehicle is used in the transportation of hazardous materials in a quantity requiring placarding under the Illinois Hazardous Materials Transportation Act. This definition shall not include farm fertilizer spreaders, machinery, and other agricultural movement equipment described in Section 3-809 nor implements of husbandry as defined in Section 1-130;

"Direct compensation" means payment made to the motor carrier by the passengers or a person acting on behalf of the passengers for the transportation services provided, and not included in a total package charge or other assessment for highway transportation services;

"Farm supplies for agricultural purposes" means products directly related to the growing or harvesting of agricultural commodities and livestock feed at any time of the year;

"Livestock" means cattle, sheep, goats, swine, poultry (including egg-producing poultry), fish used for food, and other animals designated by the Secretary of the United States

- 1 Department of Transportation (at his or her sole discretion)
- 2 that are part of a foundation herd (including producing dairy
- 3 cattle) or offspring;
- "Officer" means Illinois State Police Officer; 4
- 5 "Person" means any natural person or individual,
- 6 association, partnership, governmental body, firm,
- 7 copartnership, joint venture, company, corporation, joint
- 8 stock company, trust, estate or any other legal entity or their
- 9 legal representative, agent or assigns.
