1	AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 968
2	AMENDMENT NO Amend Senate Bill 968 by replacing
3	everything after the enacting clause with the following:
4	"Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by
5	changing Section 18b-101 as follows:
6	(625 ILCS 5/18b-101) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 18b-101)
7	Sec. 18b-101. Definitions. Unless the context otherwise
8	clearly requires, as used in this Chapter:
9	"Agricultural commodities" means any agricultural
10	commodity, non-processed food, feed, fiber, or livestock,
11	including insects.
12	"Agricultural operations" means the operation of a motor
13	vehicle or combination of vehicles transporting agricultural
14	commodities or farm supplies for agricultural purposes.
15	"Air mile" means a nautical mile, which is equivalent to
16	6,076 feet or 1,852 meters. Accordingly, 100 air miles are

1 equivalent to 115.08 statute miles or 185.2 kilometers.

2 "Commercial motor vehicle" means any self propelled or 3 towed vehicle used on public highways in interstate and 4 intrastate commerce to transport passengers or property when 5 the vehicle has a gross vehicle weight, a gross vehicle weight 6 rating, a gross combination weight, or a gross combination weight rating of 10,001 or more pounds; or the vehicle is used 7 8 or designed to transport more than 15 passengers, including the 9 driver; or the vehicle is designed to carry 15 or fewer 10 passengers and is operated by a contract carrier transporting 11 employees in the course of their employment on a highway of this State; or the vehicle is used or designed to transport 12 13 between 9 and 15 passengers, including the driver, for direct compensation, if the vehicle is being operated beyond a radius 14 15 of 75 air miles (86.3 statute miles or 138.9 kilometers) from 16 the driver's normal work reporting location; or the vehicle is used in the transportation of hazardous materials in a quantity 17 requiring placarding under the Illinois Hazardous Materials 18 Transportation Act. This definition shall not include farm 19 20 machinery, fertilizer spreaders, and other special 21 agricultural movement equipment described in Section 3-809 nor 22 implements of husbandry as defined in Section 1-130;

"Direct compensation" means payment made to the motor carrier by the passengers or a person acting on behalf of the passengers for the transportation services provided, and not included in a total package charge or other assessment for 09700SB0968sam001

highway transportation services;

"Farm supplies for agricultural purposes" means products 2 directly related to the growing or harvesting of agricultural 3 commodities and livestock feed at any time of the year; 4

5 "Livestock" means cattle, sheep, goats, swine, poultry 6 (including egg-producing poultry), fish used for food, and 7 other animals designated by the Secretary of the United States Department of Transportation (at his or her sole discretion) 8 9 that are part of a foundation herd (including producing dairy 10 cattle) or offspring;

"Officer" means Illinois State Police Officer; 11

12 "Person" any natural person or means individual, 13 governmental body, firm, association, partnership, 14 copartnership, joint venture, company, corporation, joint 15 stock company, trust, estate or any other legal entity or their 16 legal representative, agent or assigns.
