1 AN ACT concerning transportation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing

 Section 4-102 as follows:
- 6 (625 ILCS 5/4-102) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 4-102)
- Sec. 4-102. Offenses relating to motor vehicles <u>and</u> and other vehicles Misdemeanors.
- 9 (a) It is a violation of this Chapter for:
- 10 (1) A person, without authority to do so, to damage a
 11 vehicle or to damage or remove any part of a vehicle;
 - (2) A person, without authority to do so, to tamper with a vehicle or go in it, on it, or work or attempt to work any of its parts, or set or attempt to set it in motion:
- 16 (3) A person to fail to report a vehicle as unclaimed 17 in accordance with the provisions of Section 4-107.
- 18 (b) Sentence. A person convicted of a violation of this
 19 Section shall be guilty of a Class A misdemeanor. A person
 20 convicted of a violation of this Section a second or subsequent
 21 time, shall be guilty of a Class 4 felony.
