1 AN ACT concerning civil law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Probate Act of 1975 is amended by changing
- 5 Section 27-2 as follows:
- 6 (755 ILCS 5/27-2) (from Ch. 110 1/2, par. 27-2)
- 7 Sec. 27-2. Attorney's fees.)
- 8 (a) $\underline{\text{The}}$ $\underline{\text{The}}$ attorney for a representative is entitled to
- 9 reasonable compensation for his services.
- 10 (b) An attorney who withdraws from representing a
- 11 representative must file a petition for fees and costs within
- 12 30 days after the withdrawal is approved by the court. If
- 13 within 30 days after the court approves the withdrawal of an
- 14 attorney from representing a representative, a motion is filed
- for an extension of time for the filing of a petition for fees
- 16 and costs, the court may grant additional time for the filing
- of that petition.
