1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 1234 2 AMENDMENT NO. . Amend Senate Bill 1234 by replacing 3 everything after the enacting clause with the following: "Section 5. The 4 Mental Health and Developmental 5 Disabilities Confidentiality Act is amended by adding Section 6 9.4 as follows: 7 (740 ILCS 110/9.4 new) Sec. 9.4. Disclosure for treatment and coordination of 8 care. For purposes of treatment and coordination of care, State agencies, including the Department of Corrections, county 10 jails, insurance companies, and integrated health systems, may 11 12 disclose records of a recipient without the recipient's consent 13 if the recipient is in a program administered or operated by

the Department of Healthcare and Family Services or the

Department of Human Services to hospitals, physicians,

therapists, emergency medical personnel, and members of an

Accountability Act (HIPAA).

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- interdisciplinary team treating a recipient with or without the 1 2 recipient's consent. Providers on an interdisciplinary care 3 team treating a recipient may disclose the recipient's records 4 without the recipient's consent to other members of the team. 5 The records that may be disclosed under this Section are services rendered, providers rendering the services, 6 pharmaceuticals prescribed or dispensed, and diagnoses. All 7 disclosures under this Section must be made in a manner 8 9 consistent with the federal Health Insurance Portability and
- 11 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 12 becoming law.".
