Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by adding Section 3-694 as follows:

- 7 Sec. 3-694. ABATE license plate.
- (a) The Secretary, upon receipt of an application made in 8 the form prescribed by the Secretary of State, may issue 10 special registration plates designated as ABATE license plates. The special plates issued under this Section shall be 11 12 affixed only to passenger vehicles of the first division, motor vehicles of the second division weighing not more than 8,000 13 14 pounds, and motorcycles. If the Secretary of State issues the special plates for passenger vehicles of the first division or 15 16 motor vehicles of the second division weighing not more than 17 8,000 pounds, then the Secretary of State must also make the special plates available for motorcycles. Plates issued under 18 19 this Section shall expire according to the multi-year procedure 20 established by Section 3-414.1 of this Code.
 - (b) The design and color of the plates shall be wholly within the discretion of the Secretary of State. The Secretary of State may, in his or her discretion, allow the plates to be

- prescribe stickers or decals as provided under Section 3-412. 3
- (c) An applicant shall be charged a \$15 fee for original 4

- fees shall be deposited into the Secretary of State Special 8
- 9 License Plate Fund.
