

## 97TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2011 and 2012 SB1804

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

35 ILCS 200/27-55a new

Provides that a deed restriction, restrictive covenant, or similar provision may not waive, prohibit, or restrict the right to notice of a public hearing or the right to object, oppose, or challenge (i) the creation of a special service area, (ii) the activation of a backup or dormant special service area, (iii) the levy of any tax of a special service area, or (iv) the issuance of bonds of a special service area. Effective immediately.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Property Tax Code is amended by adding
- 5 Section 27-55a as follows:
- 6 (35 ILCS 200/27-55a new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 27-55a.</u> Restrictive covenants; waiver of certain
- 8 rights. A deed restriction, restrictive covenant, or similar
- 9 provision may not waive, prohibit, or restrict the right to
- notice of a public hearing or the right to object, oppose, or
- challenge (i) the creation of a special service area, (ii) the
- 12 activation of a backup or dormant special service area, (iii)
- 13 the levy of any tax of a special service area, or (iv) the
- 14 issuance of bonds of a special service area. Any such deed
- 15 <u>restriction</u>, <u>restrictive covenant</u>, <u>or similar provision shall</u>
- 16 not be enforceable and is null and void against the property
- owner, lot or unit owner of the common interest community,
- 18 condominium, or cooperative. The term "common interest
- 19 community" in this Section has the same meaning as set forth in
- 20 Section 9-102(c) of the Code of Civil Procedure.
- 21 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 22 becoming law.
