1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 1948

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 1948, AS AMENDED,
3 by replacing everything after the enacting clause with the
4 following:

5 "Section 5. The Children's Health Insurance Program Act is
6 amended by adding Section 65 as follows:

7 (215 ILCS 106/65 new)

8 Sec. 65. Dental home initiative. The Department, in
9 cooperation with the dental community and other affected
10 organizations such as Head Start, shall work to develop and
11 promote the concept of a dental home for children covered under
12 this Act. Included in this dental home outreach should be an
13 effort to ensure an ongoing relationship between the patient
14 and the dentist with an effort to provide comprehensive,
15 coordinated, oral health care so that all children covered
16 under this Act have access to preventative and restorative oral

1 health care.

2 Section 10. The Covering ALL KIDS Health Insurance Act is
3 amended by adding Section 54 as follows:

4 (215 ILCS 170/54 new)

5 Sec. 54. Dental home initiative. The Department, in
6 cooperation with the dental community and other affected
7 organizations such as Head Start, shall work to develop and
8 promote the concept of a dental home for children covered under
9 this Act. Included in this dental home outreach should be an
10 effort to ensure an ongoing relationship between the patient
11 and the dentist with an effort to provide comprehensive,
12 coordinated, oral health care so that all children covered
13 under this Act have access to preventative and restorative oral
14 health care.

15 Section 15. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by
16 adding Section 5-5.06 as follows:

17 (305 ILCS 5/5-5.06 new)

18 Sec. 5-5.06. Dental home initiative. The Department, in
19 cooperation with the dental community and other affected
20 organizations such as Head Start, shall work to develop and
21 promote the concept of a dental home for children covered under
22 this Article. Included in this dental home outreach should be

1 an effort to ensure an ongoing relationship between the patient
2 and the dentist with an effort to provide comprehensive,
3 coordinated, oral health care so that all children covered
4 under this Article have access to preventative and restorative
5 oral health care.

6 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
7 becoming law.".
