AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

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ARTICLE 1

5	Section 5. "Operational expenses" defined. For the
6	purposes of this Act, the term "operational expenses"
7	includes the following items:
8	(a) Personal Services;
9	(b) State contributions to Social Security;
10	(c) Group Insurances;
11	(d) Contractual Services;
12	(e) Travel;
13	(f) Commodities;
14	(g) Printing;
15	(h) Equipment;
16	(i) Electronic data processing;
17	(j) Telecommunications services;
18	(k) Operation of automotive equipment;
19	(1) Refunds;
20	(m) Employee retirement contributions paid by the employer;
21	(n) Permanent improvements;
22	(o) Deposits to other funds.

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ARTICLE 2

Section 5. The amount of \$13,091,050, or so much thereof 2 3 as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the 4 President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives for furnishing the items provided in Section 5 4 of the General Assembly Compensation Act to members of 6 7 their respective houses throughout the year in connection 8 with their legislative duties and responsibilities and not in 9 connection with any political campaign as prescribed by law. 10 Of this amount, 37.436% is appropriated to the President of 11 the Senate for such expenditures and 62.564% is appropriated 12 to the Speaker of the House for such expenditures.

13 Section 10. Payments from the amounts appropriated in 14 Section 5 hereof shall be made only upon the delivery of a 15 voucher approved by the member to the State Comptroller. The 16 voucher shall also be approved by the President of the Senate 17 or the Speaker of the House of Representatives as the case 18 may be.

19 Section 15. The amount of \$20,073,837, or so much 20 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to 21 meet the ordinary and incidental expenses of the Senate SB2315 Engrossed -3- SDS097 00089 BAS 40089 b

1 legislative leadership and legislative staff assistants and the House Majority and Minority leadership staff, general 2 staff and office operations. Of this amount, 25.07% 3 is 4 appropriated to the President of the Senate for such expenditures, 25.07% is appropriated to the Senate Minority 5 6 Leader for such expenditures and 24.43% is appropriated to the Speaker of the House for such expenditures, and 24.43% is 7 8 appropriated to the House Minority Leader for such 9 expenditures.

10 Section 20. The amount of \$9,382,100, or so much thereof as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the 11 12 President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of 13 Representatives for the ordinary and incidental expenses of committees, the general staff and operations, per diem 14 15 employees, special and standing committees, expenses incurred 16 in transcribing and printing of debates. Of this amount, 17 43.018% is appropriated to the President of the Senate for such expenditures and 56.982% is appropriated to the Speaker 18 19 of the House for such expenditures.

20 Section 25. The amount of \$298,490, or so much thereof 21 as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the 22 President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of 23 Representatives for the ordinary and incidental expenses, SB2315 Engrossed -4- SDS097 00089 BAS 40089 b

1 also including the purchasing on contract as required by law of printing, binding, printing paper, stationery and office 2 supplies. For the House, no part of which shall be expended 3 for expenses of purchasing, handling or distributing such 4 supplies and against which no indebtedness shall be incurred 5 6 without the written approval of the Speaker of the House of Representatives. Of this amount, 68.175% is appropriated to 7 the President of the Senate for such expenditures and 31.825% 8 9 appropriated to the Speaker of the House for such is 10 expenditures.

11 Section 30. The amount of \$4,378,008, or so much thereof 12 as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the 13 President of the Senate for the use of standing committees 14 for expert witnesses, technical services, consulting 15 assistance and other research assistance associated with 16 special studies and long range research projects which may be 17 requested by the standing committees and the Speaker of the 18 House of Representatives for Standing House Committees 19 pursuant to the Legislative Commission Reorganization Act of 20 1984. Of this amount, 45.587% is appropriated to the 21 President of the Senate for such expenditures and 54.413% is 22 appropriated to the Speaker of the House for such 23 expenditures.

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1 Section 35. The amount of \$158,650, or so much thereof as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the 2 President of the Senate and the Senate Minority Leader for 3 particular and additional services allowances for the 4 appertaining to or entailed by the respective officers of the 5 6 Senate. Of this amount, 50% is appropriated to the President of the Senate for such expenditures and 50% is appropriated 7 to the Senate Minority Leader for such expenditures. 8

9 Section 40. The amount of \$88,100, or so much thereof as 10 may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of 11 12 Representatives for travel, including expenses to Springfield 13 of members on official legislative business during weeks when the General Assembly is not in session. Of this amount, 14 15 65.5% is appropriated to the President of the Senate for such 16 expenditures and 34.5% is appropriated to the Speaker of the 17 House for such expenditures.

18 Section 45. The amount of \$441,600, or so much thereof 19 necessary and remains unexpended from as be an may appropriation heretofore made for such purposes in Article 20 70, Section 45 of Public Act 96-956, is appropriated to the 21 22 Speaker of the House for expenses in connection with the planning and preparation of redistricting of legislative and 23

3 Section 50. The amount of \$341,600, or so much thereof 4 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 5 Fund to the General Assembly to meet ordinary and contingent 6 expenses. Any use of funds appropriated under this Section 7 must be approved jointly by the Clerk of the House of 8 Representatives and the Secretary of the Senate.

9 Section 55. As used in Section 15 hereof, except where 10 the approval of the Speaker of the House of Representatives 11 is expressively required for the expenditure of or the 12 incurring of indebtedness against an appropriation for certain purchases on contract, "Speaker" means the leader of 13 14 the party having the largest number of members of the House 15 of Representatives as of January 14, 2011, and "Minority 16 Leader" means the leader of the party having the second 17 largest number of members of the House of Representatives as 18 of January 14, 2011.

19 Section 60. The sum of \$113,700, or so much thereof as 20 may be necessary, is appropriated for the ordinary and 21 contingent expenses of the Senate Operations Commission 22 including the planning costs, construction costs, moving SB2315 Engrossed -7- SDS097 00089 BAS 40089 b expenses and all other costs associated with the construction and reconstruction of Senate offices in the Capitol Complex area.

Section 65. The following named sums, or so much thereof 4 5 be necessary and remain unexpended from as may an appropriation hereto made for such purposes in Section 70 of 6 Article 70 of Public Act 96-956, as amended, are re-7 8 appropriated for expenses in connection with the planning and 9 preparation of redistricting of Legislative and 10 Representative Districts as required by Article IV, Section 3 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970: 11

The following named sums, or so much thereof 16 as may be necessary and remain unexpended from an appropriation hereto made for such purposes in Section 75 of 17 Article 70 of Public Act 96-956, as amended, are re-18 19 appropriated for expenses in connection with the planning and 20 preparation redistricting of Legislative of and 21 Representative Districts as required by Article IV, Section 3 22 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970:

 Section 75. The amount of \$500,000, or so much thereof 3 as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated from the 4 5 General Assembly Operations Revolving Fund to the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives 6 to meet ordinary and contingent expenses. Of this amount, 7 8 50% is appropriated to the President of the Senate for such 9 expenditures and 50% is appropriated to the Speaker of the 10 House for such expenditures.

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ARTICLE 3

Section 5. The amount of \$2,743,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Commission on Government Forecasting and Accountability to meet its operational expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012.

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ARTICLE 4

ARTICLE 5

3 Section 5. The amount of \$231,000, or so much thereof as 4 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 5 Fund to the Legislative Audit Commission to meet its 6 operational expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30, 7 2012.

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ARTICLE 6

9 Section 5. The amount of \$2,784,500, or so much thereof 10 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 11 Fund to the Legislative Research Unit to meet its operational 12 expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012.

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ARTICLE 7

14 Section 5. The amount of \$2,364,900, or so much thereof 15 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 16 Fund to the Legislative Reference Bureau to meet its 17 operational expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30, 18 2012. 8 Section 5. The amount of \$5,166,700, or so much thereof 9 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 10 Fund to the Legislative Information System to meet its 11 operational expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30, 12 2012.

Section 10. The following amount, or so much of that amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Assembly Computer Equipment Revolving Fund to the Legislative Information System:

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2 Section 5. The sum of \$312,500, or so much thereof as 3 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Legislative Ethics 4 Commission to meet the ordinary and contingent expenses of 5 the Commission and the Office of Legislative Inspector 6 General.

ARTICLE 11

8 Section 5. The amount of \$1,669,500, or so much thereof 9 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 10 Fund to the Architect of the Capitol to meet its operational 11 expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1, 2011.
