AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

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ARTICLE 1

Section 5. The amount of \$13,091,050, or so much thereof 5 as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the 6 7 President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of 8 Representatives for furnishing the items provided in Section 9 4 of the General Assembly Compensation Act to members of 10 their respective houses throughout the year in connection 11 with their legislative duties and responsibilities and not in 12 connection with any political campaign as prescribed by law. 13 Of this amount, 37.436% is appropriated to the President of 14 the Senate for such expenditures and 62.564% is appropriated 15 to the Speaker of the House for such expenditures.

Section 10. Payments from the amounts appropriated in Section 5 hereof shall be made only upon the delivery of a voucher approved by the member to the State Comptroller. The voucher shall also be approved by the President of the Senate or the Speaker of the House of Representatives as the case may be. SB2390 Engrossed -2- SDS097 00052 BAS 40052 b

Section 15. The amount of \$20,338,646 or so much thereof 1 2 as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to meet 3 ordinary and incidental expenses of the the Senate legislative leadership and legislative staff assistants and 4 5 the House Majority and Minority leadership staff, general staff and office operations. Of this amount, 24.73% 6 is appropriated to the President of the Senate for such 7 8 expenditures, 26.04% is appropriated to the Senate Minority 9 Leader for such expenditures and 25.12% is appropriated to 10 the Speaker of the House for such expenditures, and 24.11% is Minority Leader 11 appropriated to the House for such 12 expenditures.

13 Section 20. The amount of \$9,382,100, or so much thereof 14 as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the 15 President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of 16 Representatives for the ordinary and incidental expenses of 17 committees, the general staff and operations, per diem 18 employees, special and standing committees, expenses incurred in transcribing and printing of debates. Of this amount, 19 20 43.018% is appropriated to the President of the Senate for 21 such expenditures and 56.982% is appropriated to the Speaker 22 of the House for such expenditures.

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1 Section 25. The amount of \$309,200, or so much thereof as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the 2 President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of 3 4 Representatives for the ordinary and incidental expenses, also including the purchasing on contract as required by law 5 6 of printing, binding, printing paper, stationery and office supplies. For the House, no part of which shall be expended 7 8 for expenses of purchasing, handling or distributing such 9 supplies and against which no indebtedness shall be incurred 10 without the written approval of the Speaker of the House of 11 Representatives. Of this amount, 69.277% is appropriated to the President of the Senate for such expenditures and 30.723% 12 13 is appropriated to the Speaker of the House for such expenditures. 14

15 Section 30. The amount of \$4,378,008, or so much thereof 16 as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the 17 President of the Senate for the use of standing committees 18 witnesses, technical services, consulting for expert 19 assistance and other research assistance associated with 20 special studies and long range research projects which may be 21 requested by the standing committees and the Speaker of the 22 House of Representatives for Standing House Committees 23 pursuant to the Legislative Commission Reorganization Act of 24 this amount, 45.587% is appropriated to the 1984. Of

The amount of \$162,825, or so much thereof 4 Section 35. 5 as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the 6 President of the Senate and the Senate Minority Leader for allowances for the particular and additional services 7 8 appertaining to or entailed by the respective officers of the 9 Of this amount, 48.7% is appropriated to Senate. the 10 President of the Senate for such expenditures and 51.3% is Senate Minority Leader 11 appropriated to the for such 12 expenditures.

13 Section 40. The amount of \$88,100, or so much thereof as 14 may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the 15 President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of 16 Representatives for travel, including expenses to Springfield of members on official legislative business during weeks when 17 18 the General Assembly is not in session. Of this amount, 19 65.5% is appropriated to the President of the Senate for such 20 expenditures and 34.5% is appropriated to the Speaker of the 21 House for such expenditures.

22 Section 45. The amount of \$441,600, or so much thereof

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1 be necessary and remains unexpended from as may an appropriation heretofore made for such purposes in Article 2 70, Section 45 of Public Act 96-956, is appropriated to the 3 Speaker of the House for expenses in connection with the 4 planning and preparation of redistricting of legislative and 5 6 representative districts as required by Article IV, Section 3 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970. 7

8 Section 50. The amount of \$341,600, or so much thereof 9 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 10 Fund to the General Assembly to meet ordinary and contingent 11 expenses. Any use of funds appropriated under this Section 12 must be approved jointly by the Clerk of the House of 13 Representatives and the Secretary of the Senate.

14 Section 55. As used in Section 15 hereof, except where 15 the approval of the Speaker of the House of Representatives 16 is expressively required for the expenditure of or the 17 incurring of indebtedness against an appropriation for 18 certain purchases on contract, "Speaker" means the leader of 19 the party having the largest number of members of the House of Representatives as of January 14, 2009, and "Minority 20 21 Leader" means the leader of the party having the second 22 largest number of members of the House of Representatives as 23 of January 14, 2009.

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Section 60. The sum of \$113,700, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Senate Operations Commission including the planning costs, construction costs, moving expenses and all other costs associated with the construction and reconstruction of Senate offices in the Capitol Complex area.

8 Section 65. The amount of \$750,000, or so much thereof 9 mav be necessary and remains unexpended from as an 10 appropriation heretofore made for such purposes in Article 11 70, Section 70 of Public Act 96-956, is appropriated to the 12 President of the Senate for expenses in connection with the planning and preparation of redistricting of legislative and 13 14 representative districts as required by Article IV, Section 3 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970. 15

Section 70. The amount of \$750,000, or so much thereof 16 17 may be necessary and remains unexpended from as an 18 appropriation heretofore made for such purposes in Article 70, Section 70 of Public Act 96-956, is appropriated to the 19 20 Minority Leader of the Senate for expenses in connection with 21 the planning and preparation of redistricting of legislative 22 and representative districts as required by Article IV,

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2 Section 75. The amount of \$750,000, or so much thereof 3 necessary and remains unexpended from as may be an appropriation heretofore made for such purposes in Article 4 5 70, Section 75 of Public Act 96-956, is appropriated to the Speaker of the House of Representatives for expenses 6 in connection with the planning and preparation of redistricting 7 8 of legislative and representative districts as required by 9 Article IV, Section 3 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970.

Section 80. The amount of \$750,000, or so much thereof 10 11 as may be necessary and remains unexpended from an 12 appropriation heretofore made for such purposes in Article 70, Section 75 of Public Act 96-956, is appropriated to the 13 14 Minority Speaker of the House of Representatives for expenses 15 connection with the planning and preparation in of 16 redistricting of legislative and representative districts as IV, Section 3 of the 17 required by Article Illinois Constitution of 1970. 18

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ARTICLE 2

6 Section 5. The amount of \$3,932,900, or so much thereof 7 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 8 Fund to the Commission on Government Forecasting and 9 Accountability to meet its operational expenses for the 10 fiscal year ending June 30, 2012.

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ARTICLE 3

Section 5. The amount of \$2,160,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Legislative Printing Unit to meet its operational expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012.

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ARTICLE 4

17 Section 5. The amount of \$233,500, or so much thereof as 18 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 19 Fund to the Legislative Audit Commission to meet its SB2390 Engrossed -9- SDS097 00052 BAS 40052 b 1 operational expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2 2012.

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ARTICLE 5

4 Section 5. The amount of \$2,930,950, or so much thereof 5 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 6 Fund to the Legislative Research Unit to meet its operational 7 expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012.

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ARTICLE 6

9 Section 5. The amount of \$2,489,400, or so much thereof 10 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 11 Fund to the Legislative Reference Bureau to meet its 12 operational expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30, 13 2012.

ARTICLE 7

15 Section 5. The amount of \$1,040,700, or so much thereof 16 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 17 Fund to the Joint Committee on Administrative Rules to meet 18 its operational expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30, 19 2012. SB2390 Engrossed

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ARTICLE 8

2 Section 5. The amount of \$5,166,700, or so much thereof 3 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 4 Fund to the Legislative Information System to meet its 5 operational expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30, 6 2012.

2 Section 5. The amount of \$1,669,500, or so much thereof 3 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 4 Fund to the Architect of the Capitol to meet its operational 5 expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012.
