1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 2390

- 2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend Senate Bill 2390 by deleting
- 3 everything after the enacting clause and replacing it with
- 4 the following:
- 5 "ARTICLE 1
- 6 Section 5. The amount of \$13,091,050, or so much thereof
- 7 as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the
- 8 President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of
- 9 Representatives for furnishing the items provided in Section
- 10 4 of the General Assembly Compensation Act to members of
- 11 their respective houses throughout the year in connection
- 12 with their legislative duties and responsibilities and not in
- 13 connection with any political campaign as prescribed by law.
- Of this amount, 37.436% is appropriated to the President of

- 1 the Senate for such expenditures and 62.564% is appropriated
- 2 to the Speaker of the House for such expenditures.
- Section 10. Payments from the amounts appropriated in Section 5 hereof shall be made only upon the delivery of a voucher approved by the member to the State Comptroller. The voucher shall also be approved by the President of the Senate or the Speaker of the House of Representatives as the case may be.
- 9 Section 15. The amount of \$20,338,646 or so much thereof 10 as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to meet and incidental expenses 11 ordinary of the 12 legislative leadership and legislative staff assistants and the House Majority and Minority leadership staff, general 13 14 staff and office operations. Of this amount, 24.73% 15 appropriated to the President of the Senate for 16 expenditures, 26.04% is appropriated to the Senate Minority 17 Leader for such expenditures and 25.12% is appropriated to 18 the Speaker of the House for such expenditures, and 24.11% is 19 appropriated to the House Minority Leader for such 20 expenditures.
- Section 20. The amount of \$9,382,100, or so much thereof as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the

1 President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives for the ordinary and incidental expenses of 2 committees, the general staff and operations, per 3 employees, special and standing committees, expenses incurred 4 in transcribing and printing of debates. Of this amount, 5 6 43.018% is appropriated to the President of the Senate for such expenditures and 56.982% is appropriated to the Speaker 7

9 Section 25. The amount of \$309,200, or so much thereof 10 as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of 11 Representatives for the ordinary and incidental expenses, 13 also including the purchasing on contract as required by law of printing, binding, printing paper, stationery and office 14 15 supplies. For the House, no part of which shall be expended 16 for expenses of purchasing, handling or distributing such 17 supplies and against which no indebtedness shall be incurred 18 without the written approval of the Speaker of the House of 19 Representatives. Of this amount, 69.277% is appropriated to 20 the President of the Senate for such expenditures and 30.723% 21 is appropriated to the Speaker of the House for such 22 expenditures.

Section 30. The amount of \$4,378,008, or so much thereof

1 as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the President of the Senate for the use of standing committees 2 witnesses, technical 3 expert services, consulting 4 assistance and other research assistance associated with special studies and long range research projects which may be 5 6 requested by the standing committees and the Speaker of the House of Representatives for Standing House Committees 7 pursuant to the Legislative Commission Reorganization Act of 8 9 1984. Of this amount, 45.587% is appropriated to the 10 President of the Senate for such expenditures and 54.413% is 11 to the Speaker of the House appropriated for 12 expenditures.

13 Section 35. The amount of \$162,825, or so much thereof as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the 14 15 President of the Senate and the Senate Minority Leader for 16 for the particular and additional services allowances 17 appertaining to or entailed by the respective officers of the Of this amount, 48.7% is appropriated to the 18 19 President of the Senate for such expenditures and 51.3% is 20 appropriated to the Senate Minority Leader for 21 expenditures.

1 the approval of the Speaker of the House of Representatives 2 is expressively required for the expenditure of or incurring of indebtedness against an appropriation 3 certain purchases on contract, "Speaker" means the leader of 4 the party having the largest number of members of the House 5 6 of Representatives as of January 14, 2009, and "Minority 7 Leader" means the leader of the party having the second largest number of members of the House of Representatives as 8 9 of January 14, 2009.

Section 60. The sum of \$113,700, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Senate Operations Commission including the planning costs, construction costs, moving expenses and all other costs associated with the construction and reconstruction of Senate offices in the Capitol Complex area.

Section 65. The amount of \$750,000, or so much thereof may be necessary and remains unexpended from as appropriation heretofore made for such purposes in Article 70, Section 70 of Public Act 96-956, is appropriated to the President of the Senate for expenses in connection with the planning and preparation of redistricting of legislative and representative districts as required by Article IV, Section 3

of the Illinois Constitution of 1970.

Section 70. The amount of \$750,000, or so much thereof necessary and remains unexpended from appropriation heretofore made for such purposes in Article 70, Section 70 of Public Act 96-956, is appropriated to the Minority Leader of the Senate for expenses in connection with the planning and preparation of redistricting of legislative and representative districts as required by Article IV, Section 3 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970.

Section 75. The amount of \$750,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary and remains unexpended from an appropriation heretofore made for such purposes in Article 70, Section 75 of Public Act 96-956, is appropriated to the Speaker of the House of Representatives for expenses in connection with the planning and preparation of redistricting of legislative and representative districts as required by Article IV, Section 3 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970.

Section 80 The amount of \$750,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary and remains unexpended from an appropriation heretofore made for such purposes in Article 70, Section 75 of Public Act 96-956, is appropriated to the Minority Speaker of the House of Representatives for expenses in connection
