SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/3-699 new

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides for the issuance of National Wild Turkey Federation license plates. Provides that in addition to the appropriate registration fees, an applicant for the special plate shall be charged a fee of \$15 at original issuance and \$2 at renewal, which shall be deposited into the Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning transportation.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by adding
5 Section 3-699 as follows:

6 (625 ILCS 5/3-699 new)

7 Sec. 3-699. National Wild Turkey Federation license
8 plates.

9 (a) The Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees and
10 applications made in the form prescribed by the Secretary, may
11 issue special registration plates designated as National Wild
12 Turkey Federation license plates. The special plates issued
13 under this Section shall be affixed only to passenger vehicles
14 of the first division or motor vehicles of the second division
15 weighing not more than 8,000 pounds. Plates issued under this
16 Section shall expire according to the multi-year procedure
17 established by Section 3-414.1 of this Code.

18 (b) The design and color of the special plates shall be
19 wholly within the discretion of the Secretary. The Secretary
20 may allow the plates to be issued as vanity plates or
21 personalized plates under Section 3-405.1 of this Code. The
22 Secretary shall prescribe stickers or decals as provided under
23 Section 3-412 of this Code.

1 (c) An applicant for the special plate shall be charged a
2 \$15 fee, in addition to the appropriate registration fee, for
3 original issuance. The \$15 fee shall be deposited into the
4 Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund, to be used by
5 the Secretary to help defray the administrative processing
6 costs. For each registration renewal period, a \$2 fee, in
7 addition to the appropriate registration fee, shall be charged
8 and shall be deposited into the Secretary of State Special
9 License Plate Fund.
