1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 2493

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 2493 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The State Finance Act is amended by adding
5 Section 5.811 as follows:

6 (30 ILCS 105/5.811 new)

7 Sec. 5.811. The National Wild Turkey Federation Fund.

8 Section 10. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by adding
9 Section 3-699 as follows:

10 (625 ILCS 5/3-699 new)

11 Sec. 3-699. National Wild Turkey Federation license
12 plates.

13 (a) The Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees and
14 applications made in the form prescribed by the Secretary, may

1 issue special registration plates designated as National Wild
2 Turkey Federation license plates. The special plates issued
3 under this Section shall be affixed only to passenger vehicles
4 of the first division or motor vehicles of the second division
5 weighing not more than 8,000 pounds. Plates issued under this
6 Section shall expire according to the multi-year procedure
7 established by Section 3-414.1 of this Code.

8 (b) The design and color of the special plates shall be
9 wholly within the discretion of the Secretary. The Secretary
10 may allow the plates to be issued as vanity plates or
11 personalized plates under Section 3-405.1 of this Code. The
12 Secretary shall prescribe stickers or decals as provided under
13 Section 3-412 of this Code.

14 (c) An applicant for the special plate shall be charged a
15 \$40 fee for original issuance in addition to the appropriate
16 registration fee. Of this fee, \$25 shall be deposited into the
17 National Wild Turkey Federation Fund and \$15 shall be deposited
18 into the Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund, to be
19 used by the Secretary to help defray the administrative
20 processing costs.

21 For each registration renewal period, a \$27 fee, in
22 addition to the appropriate registration fee, shall be charged.
23 Of this fee, \$25 shall be deposited into the National Wild
24 Turkey Federation Fund and \$2 shall be deposited into the
25 Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund.

26 (d) The National Wild Turkey Federation Fund is created as

1 a special fund in the State treasury. All moneys in the
2 National Wild Turkey Federation Fund shall be paid, subject to
3 appropriation by the General Assembly and distribution by the
4 Secretary, as grants to National Wild Turkey Federation, Inc.,
5 a tax exempt entity under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal
6 Revenue Code, to fund turkey habitat protection, enhancement,
7 and restoration projects in the State of Illinois, to fund
8 education and outreach for media, volunteers, members, and the
9 general public regarding turkeys and turkey habitat
10 conservation in the State of Illinois, and to cover the
11 reasonable cost for National Wild Turkey Federation special
12 plate advertising and administration of the conservation
13 projects and education program."
