Section 5. The Property Tax Code is amended by changing
Sections 10-370 and 10-380 as follows:

6 (35 ILCS 200/10-370)

Sec. 10-370. Definitions. For the purposes of this Division14:

9 (a) "PPV Lease" means a leasehold interest in property that is exempt from taxation under Section 15-50 of this Code and 10 that is leased, pursuant to authority set forth in Chapter 10 11 of the United States Code, to another whose property is not 12 exempt for the purpose of, after January 1, 2006, the design, 13 14 finance, construction, renovation, management, operation, and 15 maintenance of rental housing units and associated 16 improvements at military naval training facilities, military 17 bases, and related military naval support facilities in the State of Illinois. All interests enjoyed pursuant to the 18 19 authority set forth in Chapter 159 or Chapter 169 of Title 10 20 of the United States Code are considered leaseholds for the 21 purposes of this Division. The changes to this Section made by 22 this amendatory Act of the 97th General Assembly apply beginning on January 1, 2006. 23

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1 (b) "Net operating income" means all revenues received 2 minus the lesser of (i) 42% of all revenues or (ii) actual 3 expenses before interest, taxes, depreciation, and 4 amortization.

5 (c) "Tax load factor" means the level of assessment, as set 6 forth under item (b) of Section 9-145 or under Section 9-150, 7 multiplied by the cumulative tax rate for the current taxable 8 year.

For the taxable years 2006 <u>and thereafter</u>, 2007, 2008, and 2009, the chief county assessment officer in the county in which property subject to a PPV Lease is located shall apply the provisions of 10-370(b)(i) and 10-375(c)(i) of this Division 14 in assessing and determining the value of any PPV Lease for purposes of the property tax laws of this State.
