Unlicensed practice; violation; civil penalty. (a) Any person who practices, offers to practice, attempts 9 10 to practice, or holds oneself out to practice dietetics or nutrition services without being licensed under this Act shall, 11 12 in addition to any other penalty provided by law, pay a civil penalty to the the Department in an amount not to exceed \$5,000 13 for each offense as determined by the Department. The civil 14

penalty shall be assessed by the Department after a hearing is

held in accordance with the provisions set forth in this Act

- 3 (b) The Department has the authority and power to
- 4 investigate any and all unlicensed activity.
- 5 (c) The civil penalty shall be paid within 60 days after
- the effective date of the order imposing the civil penalty. The 6
- 7 order shall constitute a judgment and may be filed and
- execution had thereon in the same manner as any judgment from 8
- 9 any court of record.
