1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 3182

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 3182 on page 3, by
3 replacing lines 6 through 7 with the following:

4 "Section 10. The Public Officer Prohibited Activities Act
5 is amended by changing Sections 1 and 1.2 as follows:

6 (50 ILCS 105/1) (from Ch. 102, par. 1)

7 Sec. 1. County board. No member of a county board, during
8 the term of office for which he or she is elected, may be
9 appointed to, accept, or hold any office other than (i)
10 chairman of the county board or member of the regional planning
11 commission by appointment or election of the board of which he
12 or she is a member, (ii) alderman of a city or member of the
13 board of trustees of a village or incorporated town if the
14 city, village, or incorporated town has fewer than 1,000
15 inhabitants and is located in a county having fewer than 50,000
16 inhabitants, ~~or~~ (iii) trustee of a forest preserve district

1 created under Section 18.5 of the Conservation District Act, or
2 (iv) trustee of a fire protection district, unless he or she
3 first resigns from the office of county board member or unless
4 the holding of another office is authorized by law. Any such
5 prohibited appointment or election is void. This Section shall
6 not preclude a member of the county board from being selected
7 or from serving as a member of a County Extension Board as
8 provided in Section 7 of the County Cooperative Extension Law,
9 as a member of an Emergency Telephone System Board as provided
10 in Section 15.4 of the Emergency Telephone System Act, or as
11 appointed members of the board of review as provided in Section
12 6-30 of the Property Tax Code. Nothing in this Act shall be
13 construed to prohibit an elected county official from holding
14 elected office in another unit of local government so long as
15 there is no contractual relationship between the county and the
16 other unit of local government. This amendatory Act of 1995 is
17 declarative of existing law and is not a new enactment.
