1 AN ACT concerning safety.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Carnival and Amusement Rides Safety Act is amended by changing Sections 2-3 and 2-4 as follows:

6 (430 ILCS 85/2-3) (from Ch. 111 1/2, par. 4053)

Sec. 2-3. There is hereby created the Carnival-Amusement Safety Board, hereafter in this Act referred to as the "Board", to consist of <u>9</u> * members. One member shall be the Director.

<u>Eight Seven members shall</u> be appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Senate. The term of members shall be 4 years, except that of those members initially appointed by the Governor, 1 shall be appointed for 3 years and 1 shall be appointed for 4 years, and of the members initially appointed pursuant to this amendatory Act of 2006, 1 shall be appointed for 3 years. Of the <u>8</u> * appointed members of the Board, <u>2</u> * shall be operators an operator of amusement rides, 1 shall be a registered professional engineer, 1 shall represent the insurance industry, and <u>4</u> * shall represent the general public. The Board shall advise the Department on carnival and amusement safety matters.
