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AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

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ARTICLE 1

5 Section 1. The following named sums, or so much thereof 6 as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and 7 purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated to meet the 8 ordinary and contingent expenses of the Department of 9 Military Affairs:

20 Section 5. The sum of \$13,000,000, or so much thereof as 21 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal Support 22 Agreement Revolving Fund to the Department of Military 23 Affairs Facilities Division for expenses related to Army 24 National Guard Facilities operations and maintenance as SB3842 -3- OMB097 00273 RFD 40273 b 1 provided for in the Cooperative Funding Agreements, including 2 costs in prior years.

3 Section 10. The sum of \$7,400, or so much thereof as may 4 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund 5 to the Department of Military Affairs Office of the Adjutant 6 General Division for expenses related to the care and 7 preservation of historic artifacts.

8 Section 15. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as 9 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Military Affairs 10 Trust Fund to the Department of Military Affairs Office of 11 the Adjutant General Division to support youth and other 12 programs, provided such amounts shall not exceed funds to be 13 made available from public or private sources.

14 Section 20. The sum of \$5,000,000, or so much thereof as 15 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Military 16 Family Relief Fund to the Department of Military Affairs 17 Office of the Adjutant General Division for the issuance of 18 grants to persons or families of persons who are members of the Illinois National Guard or Illinois residents who are 19 20 members of the armed forces of the United States and who have 21 been called to active duty as a result of the September 11, 22 2001 terrorist attacks, including costs in prior years.

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1 Section 25. The sum of \$466,500, or so much thereof as 2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 3 Fund to the Department of Military Affairs Facilities 4 Division for a cash transfer to the Federal Support Agreement 5 Revolving Fund for expenses for operations and maintenance 6 according to the Joint-Use Agreement, including costs in 7 prior years.

8 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,9 2012.
