A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much
5 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects
6 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated to the Board
7 of the Trustees of Southern Illinois University to meet its
8 ordinary and contingent expenses for the fiscal year ending
9 June 30, 2013:

10 Payable from the Education Assistance Fund:

11	For Personal Services, including payment	
12	to the university for personal services	
13	costs incurred during the fiscal year	
14	and salaries accrued but unpaid to academic	
15	personnel for personal services rendered	
16	during the 2012-2013 academic year	\$197,712,000
17	For State Contributions to Social	
18	Security, for Medicare	2,346,700
19	For Group Insurance	3,060,000
20	For Contractual Services	9,826,700
21	For Travel	36,600
22	For Commodities	902,800
23	For Equipment	1,006,200

1	For Telecommunications Services	1,507,300
2	For Operation of Automotive Equipment	633,200

5 Section 10. The sum of \$20,000, or so much thereof as
6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State College and
7 University Trust Fund to the Board of Trustees of Southern
8 Illinois University for scholarship grant awards, in
9 accordance with Public Act 91-83.

10 Section 15. The sum of \$1,250,000, or so much thereof as
11 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General
12 Professions Dedicated Fund to the Board of Trustees of
13 Southern Illinois University for all costs associated with
14 the development, support, or administration of pharmacy
15 practice education or training programs at the Edwardsville
16 campus.

17 Section 20. The sum of \$1,200,000, or so much thereof as
18 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
19 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of Southern Illinois
20 University for all costs associated with the SimmonsCooper
21 Cancer Center.

1 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
2 2012.
