WHEREAS, The United States Postal Service is considering 2 3 reducing delivery service from six days a week to five days a 4 week; and 5 WHEREAS, American citizens, businesses, and organizations 6 have depended on six-day mail service for the timely delivery 7 of important documents since 1912, especially working families 8 who rely on the U.S. Postal Service for delivery of paychecks; 9 and 10 WHEREAS, The reduction in service will inevitably create a backlog of undelivered mail, as postal workers would have to 11 12 handle the same amount of mail in a shorter period of time; and 13 WHEREAS, This backlog would create delays in mail delivery and increase the costs of mail service as postal workers would 14 15 have to work overtime hours to ensure timely delivery of the 16 mail; therefore, be it 17 RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-SEVENTH GENERAL 18 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we urge the United States Postal Service to maintain a six-day a week mail 19
