1 SENATE RESOLUTION

- 12 RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-SEVENTH GENERAL
- ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we designate April of
- 14 2012 as Fair Housing Month in the State of Illinois in
- 15 furtherance of this noble goal; and be it further
- 16 RESOLVED, That a suitable copy of this resolution be
- 17 presented to the Interfaith Housing Center of the Northern
- 18 Suburbs as a symbol of our esteem and respect.
