SENATE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, One of the purposes of the correctional system is 3 rehabilitation and to provide an inmate with skills to lead a 4 lawful and productive life after release from incarceration; 5 and

6 WHEREAS, The Vandalia Correctional Center has plenty of 7 land and fencing suitable for the care of horses; and

8 WHEREAS, The grooming of thoroughbred horses is a skill 9 that can be taught to inmates and can lead them to a productive 10 life after prison; and

11 WHEREAS, The program to accomplish this purpose could be 12 established at no cost to the taxpayers since the Thoroughbred 13 Retirement Foundation and the Illinois Horsemen's Benevolent 14 and Protective Association will provide all that's needed to 15 care for the horses, including feed, hay, all equipment needed 16 for the horses, retired thoroughbred horses, farriers, and 17 veterinary care; and

18 WHEREAS, Similar programs have been established in 8 other 19 states and the recidivism rate of inmates participating in 20 those programs is low; and SR0791 -2- LRB097 21661 RLC 69998 r WHEREAS, An inmate can be trained to care for 2 or 3 horses for a 6 month period and receive a certificate that states that he completed the program and is qualified to work as a groomer on a horse farm or race track; therefore, be it

5 RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-SEVENTH GENERAL 6 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we urge the Department 7 of Corrections to establish a thoroughbred horse groomer 8 training program at the Vandalia Correctional Center; and be it 9 further
