Section 5. The Unified Code of Corrections is amended by
changing Section 5-9-1.14 as follows:

7 Sec. 5-9-1.14. Additional child pornography fines. In addition to any other penalty imposed, a fine of \$500 shall be 8 9 imposed upon a person convicted of child pornography under 10 Section 11-20.1 of the Criminal Code of 1961 or the Criminal Code of 2012. The Such additional fine shall be assessed by the 11 court imposing sentence and shall be collected by the circuit 12 clerk. Of this fee, \$5 shall be deposited into the Circuit 13 14 Court Clerk Operation and Administrative Fund created by the circuit clerk Clerk of the Circuit Court to be used to offset 15 16 the costs incurred by the circuit clerk Circuit Court Clerk in 17 performing the additional duties required to collect and disburse funds to entities of State and local government as 18 19 provided by law. Each such additional fine shall be remitted by the circuit clerk Circuit Court Clerk within one month after 20 21 receipt to the unit of local or State government whose law 22 enforcement officers investigated the case that gave rise to the conviction of the defendant for child pornography. 7	electronic forensic examination assistance, or both, to
8	another law enforcement agency which investigated the case that
9	gave rise to the conviction of the defendant for child
10	pornography, \$100 of the additional fine shall be remitted by
11	the circuit clerk within one month after receipt to the State
12	Treasurer for deposit into the State Crime Laboratory Fund.
