      include, but are not limited to: animal safety harnesses,

      modified seat belts, tethers, and crates.
          (b) A driver may not operate a motor vehicle that contains

- (c) Failure to secure and protect a domestic animal by an 8
- 9 animal restraint system shall not be considered evidence of
- 10 negligence, shall not limit the liability of an insurer, and
- 11 shall not diminish any recovery for damages arising out of the
- ownership, maintenance, or operation of a motor vehicle. 12
- 13 (d) A person who violates this Section is guilty of a petty
- 14 offense. First time offenders shall be issued a warning, but
- 15 for any second or subsequent offense violators shall be subject
- 16 to a fine not to exceed \$25.
- (e) A law enforcement officer may not search a motor 17
