1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 1581 2 AMENDMENT NO. . Amend House Bill 1581, AS AMENDED, by 3 replacing everything after the enacting clause with the 4 following: "Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by adding 5 6 Section 11-1432 as follows: 7 (625 ILCS 5/11-1432 new) Sec. 11-1432. Domestic animals in motor vehicles. 8 (a) For purposes of this Section, "animal restraint system" 9 means a device which humanely restricts the movement of a 10 11 domestic animal and keeps the animal secured within a motor 12 vehicle's passenger area during transport. These devices include, but are not limited to: animal safety harnesses, 13 modified seat belts, tethers, and crates. 14 15 (b) While operating a motor vehicle, no person shall hold in their lap, or allow to be in the operator's immediate area, 16

- 1 any animal that interferes with the driver's control over the
- driving mechanism of the vehicle. In order to comply with this 2
- Section an operator of a motor vehicle may utilize an animal 3
- 4 restraint system. This Section shall not apply to the following
- 5 motor vehicles as defined by this Code:
- (1) commercial motor vehicles; 6
- 7 (2) farm tractors;
- 8 (3) implements of husbandry; and
- 9 (4) farm to market agricultural transportation.
- 10 (c) Failure to use an animal restraint system shall not be
- considered evidence of negligence, shall not limit the 11
- liability of an insurer, and shall not diminish any recovery 12
- for damages arising out of the ownership, maintenance, or 13
- 14 operation of a motor vehicle.
- 15 (d) A person who violates this Section is quilty of a petty
- 16 offense. First time offenders shall be issued a warning, but
- for any second or subsequent offense violators shall be subject 17
- to a fine not to exceed \$25. 18
- (e) A law enforcement officer may not search a motor 19
- 20 vehicle, its contents, the driver, or a passenger solely
- 21 because of a violation or suspected violation of this Section.
- 22 Section 10. The Code of Criminal Procedure of 1963 is
- amended by changing Section 108-1 as follows: 23
- (725 ILCS 5/108-1) (from Ch. 38, par. 108-1) 24

- 1 Sec. 108-1. Search without warrant.
- 2 (1) When a lawful arrest is effected a peace officer may
- 3 reasonably search the person arrested and the area within such
- 4 person's immediate presence for the purpose of:
- 5 (a) protecting the officer from attack; or
- 6 (b) preventing the person from escaping; or
- 7 (c) discovering the fruits of the crime; or
- 8 (d) discovering any instruments, articles, or things
- 9 which may have been used in the commission of, or which may
- 10 constitute evidence of, an offense.
- 11 (2) (Blank).
- 12 (3) A law enforcement officer may not search or inspect a
- motor vehicle, its contents, the driver, or a passenger solely
- 14 because of a violation of Section 12-603.1 of the Illinois
- 15 Vehicle Code.
- 16 (4) A law enforcement officer may not search a motor
- 17 vehicle, its contents, the driver, or a passenger solely
- 18 because of a violation or suspected violation of Section
- 19 11-1432 of the Illinois Vehicle Code.
