1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 1809

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend House Bill 1809 by replacing  
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by  
5 changing Section 1-159.1 as follows:

6 (625 ILCS 5/1-159.1) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 1-159.1)

7 Sec. 1-159.1. Person with disabilities. A natural person  
8 who, as determined by a licensed physician, by a physician  
9 assistant who has been delegated the authority to make this  
10 determination by his or her supervising physician, or by an  
11 advanced practice nurse who has a written collaborative  
12 agreement with a collaborating physician that authorizes the  
13 advanced practice nurse to make this determination: (1) cannot  
14 walk without the use of, or assistance from, a brace, cane,  
15 crutch, another person, prosthetic device, wheelchair, or  
16 other assistive device; (2) is restricted by lung disease to

1 such an extent that his or her forced (respiratory) expiratory  
2 volume for one second, when measured by spirometry, is less  
3 than one liter, or the arterial oxygen tension is less than 60  
4 mm/hg on room air at rest; (3) uses portable oxygen; (4) has a  
5 cardiac condition to the extent that the person's functional  
6 limitations are classified in severity as Class III or Class  
7 IV, according to standards set by the American Heart  
8 Association; (5) is severely limited in the person's ability to  
9 walk due to an arthritic, neurological, oncological, or  
10 orthopedic condition; (6) cannot walk 200 feet without stopping  
11 to rest because of one of the above 5 conditions; or (7) is  
12 missing a hand or arm or has permanently lost the use of a hand  
13 or arm.
