1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 1969

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 1969 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Election Code is amended by changing
5 Section 1-8 as follows:

6 (10 ILCS 5/1-8)

7 Sec. 1-8. Canvassing boards abolished. Notwithstanding any
8 other provision of this Code, local canvassing boards are
9 abolished. In this Code or any other law a reference to a local
10 or county canvassing board means (i) for elections in which the
11 political subdivision that is choosing candidates or
12 submitting a public question is located entirely within the
13 jurisdiction of a single election authority, that election
14 authority and (ii) for elections for offices and public
15 questions not listed in Section 22-1 of this Code in which the
16 political subdivision that is choosing candidates or

1 submitting a public question is located within the jurisdiction
2 of 2 or more election authorities, the election authority
3 having jurisdiction over the location at which the political
4 subdivision has its principal office; however if a political
5 subdivision that is choosing candidates or submitting a public
6 question is located within the jurisdiction of 2 or more
7 election authorities and has its principal office located in
8 the territorial jurisdiction of a city board of election
9 commissioners, then the city board of election commissioners
10 shall not have jurisdiction. In that case, the election
11 authority in which a majority of the territory of the city
12 board of election commissioners is located shall have
13 jurisdiction.
