Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 8 Sec. 1. Purpose. The The purpose of this Act is to protect
- 9 the hearing-impaired public from incompetent and dishonest
- 10 dispensers of hearing instruments who could endanger the
- 11 health, safety and welfare of the People of this State. The
- 12 Federal Food and Drug Administration has recommended that State
- 13 legislation is necessary in order to establish standards of
- 14 competency and to impose stringent penalties for those who
- violate the public trust in this field of health care.
