1 AN ACT concerning regulation.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Nurse Practice Act is amended by changing
Section 75-15 as follows:

8 Sec. 75-15. Center for Nursing Advisory Board.

9 (a) There is created the Center for Nursing Advisory Board, which shall consist of 11 members appointed by the Governor, 10 Advisory Board being 11 with 6 members of the nurses 12 representative of various nursing specialty areas. The other 5 members may include representatives of associations, health 13 14 care providers, nursing educators, and consumers. The Advisory Board shall be chaired by the Nursing Act Coordinator, who 15 16 shall be a voting member of the Advisory Board.

17 (b) The membership of the Advisory Board shall reasonably18 reflect representation from the geographic areas in this State.

(c) Members of the Advisory Board appointed by the Governor shall serve for terms of 4 years, with no member serving more than 10 successive years, except that, initially, 4 members shall be appointed to the Advisory Board for terms that expire on June 30, 2009, 4 members shall be appointed to the Advisory HB2638 Enrolled - 2 - LRB098 07100 MGM 37161 b

Board for terms that expire on June 30, 2008, and 3 members shall be appointed to the Advisory Board for terms that expire on June 30, 2007. A member shall serve until his or her successor is appointed and has qualified. Vacancies shall be filled in the same manner as original appointments, and any member so appointed shall serve during the remainder of the term for which the vacancy occurred.

8 (d) A quorum of the Advisory Board shall consist of a 9 majority of Advisory Board members currently serving. A 10 majority vote of the quorum is required for Advisory Board 11 decisions. A vacancy in the membership of the Advisory Board 12 shall not impair the right of a quorum to exercise all of the 13 rights and perform all of the duties of the Advisory Board.

14 (e) The Governor may remove any appointed member of the 15 Advisory Board for misconduct, incapacity, or neglect of duty 16 and shall be the sole judge of the sufficiency of the cause for 17 removal.

(f) Members of the Advisory Board are immune from suit in any action based upon any activities performed in good faith as members of the Advisory Board.

(g) Members of the Advisory Board shall not receive compensation, but shall be reimbursed for actual traveling, incidentals, and expenses necessarily incurred in carrying out their duties as members of the Advisory Board, as approved by the Department.

26 (h) The Advisory Board shall meet annually to elect a
