## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/11-1432 new

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides that no person may smoke cigarettes, cigars, or pipes of any kind in a motor vehicle containing a minor under 13 years of age. Provides that a violation of this Section is a petty offense subject to a fine not to exceed \$100. Provides that a violation of this Section is not cause to stop or search a motor vehicle or the driver of a motor vehicle.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by adding Section 11-1432 as follows:
- 6 (625 ILCS 5/11-1432 new)
- Sec. 11-1432. Smoking in a motor vehicle with a minor
- 8 present.
- 9 (a) For the purposes of this Section, "smoke" means the
- 10 possession of any lighted pipe, cigar, or cigarette of any kind
- or any other lighted smoking equipment or the lighting,
- 12 <u>inhaling</u>, or exhaling of smoke from a pipe, cigar, or cigarette
- of any kind.
- 14 (b) It shall be unlawful for a person to smoke in a motor
- vehicle, whether in motion or at rest, that contains a person
- 16 younger than 13 years of age.
- 17 (c) A person that violates this Section shall be quilty of
- a petty offense and subject to a fine not to exceed \$100.
- 19 (d) A law enforcement officer may not stop or search a
- 20 <u>motor vehicle</u>, its contents, the driver, or a passenger solely
- 21 because of a violation or suspected violation of this Section.
