SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

305 ILCS 5/12-4.7b-1 new

Amends the Illinois Public Aid Code. Requires the Department of Human Services (Department) to enter into an agreement with the Illinois Department of Corrections (IDOC) to allow the Department's database of public aid recipients to cross-reference with IDOC's database of incarcerated persons. Provides that public aid recipients who are inmates at a State correctional facility operated by IDOC shall be subject to an immediate suspension of their public aid benefits, including the immediate deactivation of their electronic benefits card or LINK card provided under the federal Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (formerly the Food Stamp Program), until the date of their scheduled release or discharge from the State correctional facility.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by adding Section 12-4.7b-1 as follows:

- 7 Sec. 12-4.7b-1. Incarcerated persons; suspension of benefits. The Department of Human Services (Department) shall 8 9 enter into an agreement with the Illinois Department of Corrections (IDOC) to allow the Department's database of public 10 aid recipients to cross-reference with IDOC's database of 11 12 incarcerated persons. Public aid recipients who are inmates at a State correctional facility operated by IDOC shall be subject 13 14 to an immediate suspension of their public aid benefits, including the immediate deactivation of their electronic 15 benefits card or LINK card provided under the federal 16 17 Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (formerly the Food Stamp Program), until the date of their scheduled release or 18 19 discharge from the State correctional facility.
