## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Makes appropriations for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the General Assembly for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2013. Effective July 1, 2013.

AN ACT concerning appropriations.

#### Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented 2 in the General Assembly: 3

4 Section 5. The amount of \$13,091,050, or so much thereof as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the 5 President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of 6 Representatives for furnishing the items provided in Section 7 8 4 of the General Assembly Compensation Act to members of 9 their respective houses throughout the year in connection 10 with their legislative duties and responsibilities and not in 11 connection with any political campaign as prescribed by law. 12 Of this amount, 37.436% is appropriated to the President of the Senate for such expenditures and 62.564% is appropriated 13 14 to the Speaker of the House for such expenditures.

15 Section 10. Payments from the amounts appropriated in 16 Section 5 hereof shall be made only upon the delivery of a 17 voucher approved by the member to the State Comptroller. The 18 voucher shall also be approved by the President of the Senate or the Speaker of the House of Representatives as the case 19 20 may be.

21 Section 15. The amount of \$20,603,400, or so much -2- LRB098 11286 JDS 42487 b

1 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to meet the ordinary and incidental expenses of the Senate 2 legislative leadership and legislative staff assistants and 3 the House Majority and Minority leadership staff, general 4 and office operations. Of this amount, 25.7% 5 staff is 6 appropriated to the President of the Senate for such expenditures, 25.7% is appropriated to the Senate Minority 7 Leader for such expenditures and 24.8% is appropriated to the 8 Speaker of the House for such expenditures, and 23.8% is 9 10 appropriated to the House Minority Leader for such 11 expenditures.

12 Section 20. The amount of \$9,882,100, or so much thereof as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the 13 President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of 14 15 Representatives for the ordinary and incidental expenses of 16 committees, the general staff and operations, per diem 17 employees, special and standing committees, expenses incurred 18 in transcribing and printing of debates. Of this amount, 19 43.018% is appropriated to the President of the Senate for 20 such expenditures and 56.982% is appropriated to the Speaker 21 of the House for such expenditures.

22 Section 25. The amount of \$309,200, or so much thereof 23 as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the

1 President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives for the ordinary and incidental expenses, 2 also including the purchasing on contract as required by law 3 of printing, binding, printing paper, stationery and office 4 supplies. For the House, no part of which shall be expended 5 6 for expenses of purchasing, handling or distributing such supplies and against which no indebtedness shall be incurred 7 without the written approval of the Speaker of the House of 8 9 Representatives. Of this amount, 69.277% is appropriated to 10 the President of the Senate for such expenditures and 30.723% 11 appropriated to the Speaker of the House for such is expenditures. 12

13 Section 30. The amount of \$6,483,050, or so much thereof as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the 14 15 President of the Senate for the use of standing committees 16 witnesses, technical services, for expert consulting 17 assistance and other research assistance associated with 18 special studies and long range research projects which may be 19 requested by the standing committees and the Speaker of the 20 of Representatives for Standing House Committees House 21 pursuant to the Legislative Commission Reorganization Act of 22 1984. Of this amount, 46.862% is appropriated to the President of the Senate for such expenditures and 53.138% is 23 to the Speaker of the House 24 appropriated for such

1 expenditures.

2 Section 35. The amount of \$167,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the 3 President of the Senate and the Senate Minority Leader for 4 5 allowances for the particular and additional services appertaining to or entailed by the respective officers of the 6 Senate. Of this amount, 50% is appropriated to the President 7 8 of the Senate for such expenditures and 50% is appropriated 9 to the Senate Minority Leader for such expenditures.

10 Section 40. The amount of \$88,100, or so much thereof as 11 may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the 12 President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives for travel, including expenses to Springfield 13 14 of members on official legislative business during weeks when 15 the General Assembly is not in session. Of this amount, 16 65.5% is appropriated to the President of the Senate for such 17 expenditures and 34.5% is appropriated to the Speaker of the 18 House for such expenditures.

19 Section 45. The amount of \$441,600, or so much thereof 20 as may be necessary and remains unexpended from an 21 appropriation heretofore made for such purposes in Article 7 22 of Public Act 97-726, is reappropriated to the Speaker of the

HB3586 -5-LRB098 11286 JDS 42487 b 1 House for expenses in connection with the planning and 2 preparation of redistricting of legislative and representative districts as required by Article IV, Section 3 3 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970. 4

5 Section 50. The amount of \$341,600, or so much thereof 6 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 7 Fund to the General Assembly to meet ordinary and contingent 8 expenses. Any use of funds appropriated under this Section 9 must be approved jointly by the Clerk of the House of 10 Representatives and the Secretary of the Senate.

11 Section 55. As used in Section 15 hereof, except where 12 the approval of the Speaker of the House of Representatives is expressively required for the expenditure of or 13 the 14 incurring of indebtedness against an appropriation for 15 certain purchases on contract, "Speaker" means the leader of 16 the party having the largest number of members of the House of Representatives as of January 9, 2013, and "Minority 17 18 Leader" means the leader of the party having the second 19 largest number of members of the House of Representatives as 20 of January 9, 2013.

21 Section 60. The sum of \$312,500, or so much thereof as 22 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Legislative Ethics HB3586 -6- LRB098 11286 JDS 42487 b 1 Commission to meet the ordinary and contingent expenses of 2 the Commission and the Office of Legislative Inspector 3 General.

4 Section 65. The sum of \$113,700, or so much thereof as 5 may be necessary, is appropriated for the ordinary and 6 contingent expenses of the Senate Operations Commission 7 including the planning costs, construction costs, moving 8 expenses and all other costs associated with the construction 9 and reconstruction of Senate offices in the Capitol Complex 10 area.

11 Section 80. The amount of \$500,000, or so much thereof 12 as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated from the General Assembly Operations Revolving Fund to the President 13 14 of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives 15 to meet ordinary and contingent expenses. Of this amount, 50% is appropriated to the President of the Senate for such 16 17 expenditures and 50% is appropriated to the Speaker of the 18 House for such expenditures.

19 Section 85. The following named sums, or so much thereof 20 as may be necessary and remain unexpended from an 21 appropriation hereto made for such purposes in Section 85 of 22 Article 7 of Public Act 97-726, as amended, are re8 Section 90.
