State Parking Maintenance Fund for maintenance of parking facilities. Makes appropriations for library grants, services, establishment, maintenance, renovation, programs, and equipment. Makes appropriations for tuition and fees for Illinois Archival Depository System Interns. Makes appropriations from numerous funds for the Secretary of State to implement the statutory purpose of those funds. Effective July 1, 2013.
