4 "Section 5. The Illinois Public Accounting Act is amended

5 by adding Section 30.9 as follows:

Sec. 30.9. Tax return preparation task force. The Department shall convene a task force consisting of 8 members, one of whom shall be appointed by the Department and be a representative of the Department; one of whom shall be appointed by the Department and be a representative of a statewide association representing CPAs; one of whom shall be appointed by the Department and be an enrolled agent or representative of the tax return preparation industry; one of whom shall be the Director of Revenue or his or her designee;

one of whom shall be appointed by the Speaker of the House of

1 Representatives; one of whom shall be appointed by the President of the Senate; one of whom shall be appointed by the 2 Minority Leader of the House of Representatives; and one of 3 4 whom shall be appointed by the Minority Leader of the Senate. 5 The task force shall prepare a report that does the following: 6 determines the appropriate scope of a program for regulating commercial tax return preparers; addresses the appropriate 7 qualifications, including, but not limited to, minimum 8 9 educational qualifications and continuing educational 10 requirements for commercial tax return preparers; and 11 considers any other matters the task force determines to be necessary or appropriate. The task force shall meet no less 12 than 3 times before the end of the year in which this 13 14 amendatory Act of the 98th General Assembly becomes effective. 15 The report required under this Section shall be submitted by no later than December 1, 2015 to the Secretary of Financial and 16 Professional Regulation, the Governor, and the General 17 Assembly. Members of the task force shall receive no 18 19 compensation, but shall be reimbursed for expenses necessarily 20 incurred in the performance of their duties.

21 This Section is repealed July 1, 2016.

22 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 23 becoming law.".
