SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

10 ILCS 5/1-8

Amends the Election Code. Provides that, if a political subdivision that is choosing candidates or submitting a public question is located within the jurisdiction of 2 or more election authorities and has its principal office located in the territorial jurisdiction of a city board of election commissioners, then the election authority in which a majority of the territory of the city board of election commissioners is located shall have jurisdiction, and the city board of election commissioners shall not have jurisdiction.

1 AN ACT concerning elections.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Election Code is amended by changing Section
- 5 1-8 as follows:
- 6 (10 ILCS 5/1-8)
- 7 Sec. 1-8. Canvassing boards abolished. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Code, local canvassing boards are 8 9 abolished. In this Code or any other law a reference to a local or county canvassing board means (i) for elections in which the 10 subdivision that is 11 political choosing candidates submitting a public question is located entirely within the 12 jurisdiction of a single election authority, that election 13 14 authority and (ii) for elections for offices and public questions not listed in Section 22-1 of this Code in which the 15 16 political subdivision that is choosing candidates 17 submitting a public question is located within the jurisdiction of 2 or more election authorities, the election authority 18 19 having jurisdiction over the location at which the political 20 subdivision has its principal office; however if a political 21 subdivision that is choosing candidates or submitting a public 22 question is located within the jurisdiction of 2 or more election authorities and has its principal office located in 23

- 1 the territorial jurisdiction of a city board of election
- 2 <u>commissioners</u>, then the city board of election commissioners
- 3 shall not have jurisdiction. In that case, the election
- 4 authority in which a majority of the territory of the city
- 5 <u>board of election commissioners is located shall have</u>
- 6 <u>jurisdiction</u>.
