SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

430 ILCS 66/60

Amends the Firearm Concealed Carry Act. Provides that a non-resident applicant for a new license or renewal shall submit \$150 (rather than \$300) with the application, of which \$120 (rather than \$250) shall be apportioned to the State Police Firearm Services Fund, \$20 (rather than \$40) shall be apportioned to the Mental Health Reporting Fund, and \$10 shall be apportioned to the State Crime Laboratory Fund.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Firearm Concealed Carry Act is amended by 5 changing Section 60 as follows:

6 (430 ILCS 66/60)

7 Sec. 60. Fees.

8 (a) All fees collected under this Act shall be deposited as 9 provided in this Section. Application, renewal, and 10 replacement fees shall be non-refundable.

11 (b) An applicant for a new license or a renewal shall 12 submit \$150 with the application, of which \$120 shall be 13 apportioned to the State Police Firearm Services Fund, \$20 14 shall be apportioned to the Mental Health Reporting Fund, and 15 \$10 shall be apportioned to the State Crime Laboratory Fund.

(c) <u>(Blank).</u> A non resident applicant for a new license or renewal shall submit \$300 with the application, of which \$250 shall be apportioned to the State Police Firearm Services Fund, \$40 shall be apportioned to the Mental Health Reporting Fund, and \$10 shall be apportioned to the State Crime Laboratory Fund.

(d) A licensee requesting a new license in accordance with
Section 55 shall submit \$75, of which \$60 shall be apportioned

1 to the State Police Firearm Services Fund, \$5 shall be 2 apportioned to the Mental Health Reporting Fund, and \$10 shall 3 be apportioned to the State Crime Laboratory Fund.
