SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

735 ILCS 5/9-122 new

Amends the Code of Civil Procedure. Provides that weather conditions may not be used as a factor in staying the enforcement of a judgment for possession of residential premises or delaying the execution of a judgment for possession of residential premises unless an occupant of the premises is under the age of 12 or over the age of 65.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Code of Civil Procedure is amended by adding

 Section 9-122 as follows:

- 7 <u>Sec. 9-122. Weather.</u>
- 8 (a) Weather conditions may not be used as a factor in
 9 staying the enforcement of a judgment for possession of
 10 residential premises unless an occupant of the premises is
 11 under the age of 12 or over the age of 65.
- 12 <u>(a) Weather conditions may not be used as a factor in</u>
 13 <u>delaying the execution of a judgment for possession of</u>
 14 <u>residential premises unless an occupant of the premises is</u>
- under the age of 12 or over the age of 65.
