Sec. 9-122. Judgment for possession; enforcement.

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, in a county with a

population of 3,000,000 or more, the following apply:

- (1) The number of motions a tenant may file to stay the enforcement of an order for possession is limited to 2, unless good cause for an additional stay is shown by written motion filed with the court and served upon the plaintiff.
- (2) The sheriff shall evict the tenant within 45 days from the date of expiration of the stay of enforcement of the order for possession entered by the court. If a motion for stay of enforcement of an order for possession is filed and denied by the court, the sheriff shall evict the tenant within 45 days of the denial. If a stay of the enforcement of an order of possession is granted, the sheriff shall evict the tenant within 45 days from the date of the expiration of the stay of enforcement of the order for
