- turned into vapor which is inhaled by the user.
- 17 (430 ILCS 40/10 new)
- 18 Sec. 10. Child-safe electronic cigarette liquids.
- 19 Electronic cigarette liquids sold and marketed for the
- 20 refilling of e-cigarettes may be sold only in special
- 21 packaging. The Department of Public Health shall adopt rules

- establishing the standards for special packaging to be used for 1
- 2 e-cigarette liquids.
- 3 This Section does not apply to electronic cigarette
- products sold in sealed, pre-filled, or disposable replacement 4
