SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

35 ILCS 5/224 new

Amends the Illinois Income Tax Act. Creates a credit for taxpayers who are employed by or volunteer for a county emergency medical services agency in a county with a population of fewer than 10,000 as a paramedic, firefighter, emergency medical technician, or ambulance driver. Provides that the credit shall be equal to 5% of the base amount of the standard exemption for individuals. Effective immediately.

FISCAL NOTE ACT MAY APPLY

1 AN ACT concerning revenue.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Income Tax Act is amended by adding
- 5 Section 224 as follows:
- 6 (35 ILCS 5/224 new)
- 7 Sec. 224. Emergency medical services employees and
- 8 volunteers tax credit. Beginning with tax years ending after
- 9 December 31, 2014, each taxpayer who is employed by or
- 10 volunteers for a county emergency medical services agency in a
- 11 county with a population of fewer than 10,000 as a paramedic,
- 12 firefighter, emergency medical technician, or ambulance driver
- 13 shall be allowed a credit against the tax imposed by
- 14 subsections (a) and (b) of Section 201 of this Act. The credit
- 15 <u>shall be equal to 5% of the base amount of the standard</u>
- 16 exemption for individuals, as defined in subsection (b) of
- 17 Section 204.
- 18 In no event shall a credit under this Section reduce the
- 19 taxpayer's liability under this Act to less than zero.
- 20 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 21 becoming law.
