Section 5. The Display of Tobacco Products Act is amended
by changing Sections 5 and 10 as follows:

7 Sec. 5. Definitions. In this Act:

8 <u>"Alternative nicotine product" has the meaning ascribed to</u> 9 <u>it in Section 1.5 of the Prevention of Tobacco Use by Minors</u> 10 <u>and Sale and Distribution of Tobacco Products Act.</u>

11 "Line of sight" means visible to a cashier or other 12 employee.

"Age restricted area" means a signed designated area in a retail establishment to which minors under 18 years of age are not permitted access unless accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.

The restrictions described in this Section do not apply to 2 3 a retail tobacco store that (i) derives at least 90% of its 4 revenue from tobacco and tobacco related products; (ii) does 5 not permit persons under the age of 18 to enter the premises 6 unless accompanied by a parent or legal guardian; and (iii) posts a sign on the main entrance way stating that persons 7 8 under the age of 18 are prohibited from entering unless accompanied by a parent or legal guardian. 9
