## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

205 ILCS 657/110 new

Amends the Transmitters of Money Act. Provides that virtual currency does not have legal tender status. Defines "virtual currency" as a medium of exchange that operates like currency in some environments, but does not have all the attributes of real currency. Effective immediately.

- 7 <u>Sec. 110. Virtual currency. Virtual currency does not have</u>
- 8 legal tender status. For the purposes of this Section, "virtual
- 9 currency" means a medium of exchange that operates like
- 10 currency in some environments, but does not have all the
- 11 <u>attributes of real currency.</u>
- 12 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 13 becoming law.
